

4.4.2 Project UDAI Outcomes till 31st March 2016

Project Outcomes as on 31st March 2016

The project took off in the month of July 2016. Since its inception and functionality in 7 facilities across Udaipur & Rajsamand districts, the team Project Udaï has achieved the following the outcomes till 31st March 2016.

The total no. of deliveries recorded from July 2016 to 31st March 2016 stood at 3,471.

Out of the deliveries recorded 2,880 (83%) of them received health education from 7 Udaï Mitra stationed at selected health facilities comprising of sub-centers, Primary Health Centers (PHCs) and Community Health Centers (CHCs). The role of the Udaï Mitra is very crucial for the successful implementation of the project followed by the Udaï Preraks. Udaï Mitra is the point of first contact with the family of the newborn and her services at the initial stage of the intervention is very critical.

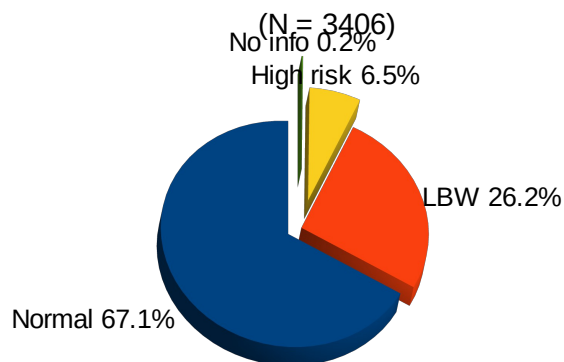
The total count of Low Birth Weight (LBW) babies stood at 1,114 and out of that 697 received the Udaï Kits from the Udaï Mitra after being properly educated on the danger signs and need for neonatal care from the Udaï Mitras.

The working call-centers conveyed information of delivery ASHAs amounting to nearly 53.6 percent of the total information conveyed. The Udaï Preraks stationed in the field areas visited 2174 newborns resulting in (62.6)percentage of visits.

The Udaï preraks during the same period reported 661 home -visits by ASHAs at least once aggregating to 30.4 percentage.

Out of the 3471 total no of deliveries recorded, no of Still Births stood at 65 giving SBR 18.7, no of neonatal deaths stood at 97 giving NMR 28.5.
